## 1.03 Club Compliance Certification Requirements

In order for District 5080 to be certified by Rotary International to operate a Rotary International Youth Exchange Program, each participating club must provide the Annual Club Compliance Certification, \*( form IB-1 USA and cIB-1 Canada) and Youth Exchange Agreement, section 1.51, due October 30th, which affirms and agrees that the club is operating the Youth Exchange program in accordance with:

- 1. the policies and procedures of all the District 5080 Youth Exchange Committee as specified in the Club Manual on the <a href="https://www.rotaryye5080.org">www.rotaryye5080.org</a> website and
- 2. its adoption of Rotary International's Statement of Conduct for working with Youth: Rotary International strives to create and maintain a safe environment for all youth who participate in Rotary activities. To the best of their ability, Rotarians, Rotarians' spouse and partners, and other volunteers must safeguard the children and young people they come into contact with and protect them from physical, sexual and emotional abuse.
