THE COG (RESIDENT DINING)

For meals in the COG, please enter Hemmingson via the NE entrance closest to the Cincinnati/Desmet.

LOST & FOUND

If you lose an item and your group hasn't seen it, check the welcome desk in the Hemmingson Center. Desk hours are 7:00 am – 7:00 pm. Please check with Security outside of these hours.

MEDICAL, FIRE AND POLICE EMERGENCIES

For situations that require Spokane Police or Spokane Fire department, call 911 first, then notify Campus Security at x2222 (from campus phones) or 313-2222 (from off campus or cell phones. The area code is 509).

We ask that you call 911 first in order to get the local emergency providers started. Calling Campus Security first often adds time to this process and the Security dispatcher won't have the same information that you do. Make it a point to know the name of the building that you are in, or the campus location, in order to help the emergency responders find you. It is important to call Campus Security after calling 911. Our officers work in cooperation with local emergency responders by assisting with directions, entry into buildings, and crowd control. We are also responsible for making the proper documentation for incidents that occur on campus and for keeping event and program organizers informed.

CAMPUS SECURITY

You can reach the Campus Security dispatcher by calling x2222 (from campus phones) or 313-2222 (from off campus or cell phones). Campus Security officers patrol the grounds and buildings of our campus and are on duty 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. There are a number of "blue light" phones around campus that dial directly to the Security dispatcher. Security officers can assist with situations that are safety and security related but that may not be an emergency. Crimes that occur on campus should be reported to Campus Security promptly.

BUILDING SAFETY AND SECURITY

The residential buildings are only as safe as the residents make them. Don't prop exterior doors on buildings or let unknown people in. Everyone in the building is put at risk when this basic safety procedure is ignored. "Crimes of opportunity" such as burglary, theft and vandalism are always a challenge that must be met. Even more serious incidents such as assault can occur when the security of the building is compromised.

Report suspicious persons and situations to Campus Security at x2222 (from campus phones) or 313-2222 (from off campus or cell phones).

Remember:

- Don't prop doors or let unknown people into residential facilities
- Close exterior doors that you find propped open
- Always keep physical control of room and building keys. Keys should never be left unattended, even for just a minute
- Don't leave individual room doors unlocked and keep valuables out of sight
- Don't leave first floor room windows open when the room is unoccupied
- Always lock the room door when turning in for the night

RESPONSE AND REPORTING

Under the Jeanne Clery Act, Gonzaga University is required to report any and all crimes that occurs on campus, no matter what the severity. If you witness an incident, please contact campus security at 509-313-2222 immediately to report it.

Please also report all sexual misconduct or gender-based harassment as regulated by Title IX to either security or Stephanie Whaley, campus Title IX coordinator, at 509-313-6910.

Please remember to contact local community resources for assistance with any incident. A limited list of some local resources can be found at the front desk for your hall.

RESIDENTIAL BUILDING STAFF

Please be aware there may be additional University staff, such as chaplains, located in each building. Their rooms will be labeled and we ask that all guests are respectful of their space.

FIRE ALARMS

Occupants of a building must evacuate when a fire alarm is activated. Take a few minutes to familiarize yourself with the layout of the building and the floor and determine the way to the nearest exit and fire alarm pull station. Every fire alarm in a residential building results in the Spokane Fire department responding on an emergency basis. Falsely activating a fire alarm is a serious criminal offense and could also result in a monetary fine from the Spokane Fire department to recover the cost of responding. Presently that is about \$750. Tampering with fire alarms, smoke detectors and other fire protection equipment puts everyone at risk.

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

It's very important to be aware of traffic movements on the streets, alleys and parking lots around campus. Don't count on drivers watching for you...walk defensively! There may be camp activity at the Warehouse, located on the east side of Hamilton Street. Hamilton is a very busy arterial and can be dangerous to cross. The pedestrian walk bridge must be used for coming and going to that location.

Our campus is experiencing a great deal of construction activity. Please be aware of potential hazards when walking near construction sites and projects. Cutting through or entering any construction site is prohibited.

SUMMER CAMP POLICIES & SAFETY INFO



WATER HAZARDS

Swimming in the Spokane River and Lake Arthur (at the south end of campus) is strictly prohibited. These two areas can be tempting on a hot day but they are not safe or suitable for swimming. The Fitness Center pool is off-limits unless staffed by a lifeguard.

LOST & FOUND

Please contact the Hemmingson Welcome Desk for inquiries on lost items between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm Monday through Friday. Phone Number is 509-313-6942. For all inquires outside of these hours, please contact Security at 509-313-2222.

Please understand that Gonzaga is not responsible for lost, stolen or “forgotten” property.

Lost keys or key cards will be charged at a rate of \$50.00 per item lost. (i.e. losing both will result in a \$100.00 fee)

ALCOHOL, SMOKING & ILLEGAL DRUGS

Smoking

Smoking, including use of electronic cigarettes, is not allowed in any Gonzaga facility, including residence halls, or within twenty-five (25) feet of entrances, exits, windows and ventilation intakes that serve an enclosed area.

Illegal Drugs and Marijuana

It is a violation of Gonzaga policy to use, possess, or distribute any drug or controlled substance.

To protect federal funding, Gonzaga University does comply with federal laws regarding recreational and medical marijuana.

Possession, use or distribution of marijuana and cannabis products are not allowed on campus.

Alcohol

Consumption of alcohol and open containers of alcoholic beverages are not allowed in public areas on Gonzaga's campus without proper approval and permits. Those wishing to serve alcohol at a private event must contact Sodexo and obey Washington State laws governing the use and purchase of alcohol.

Chaperones and others serving in a supervisory capacity for the camp are not allowed to consume alcohol while on duty, including nights when they are on supervisory watch over students.

Minors are not allowed to consume or possess alcoholic beverages.

Minors must be supervised at all times while on campus.

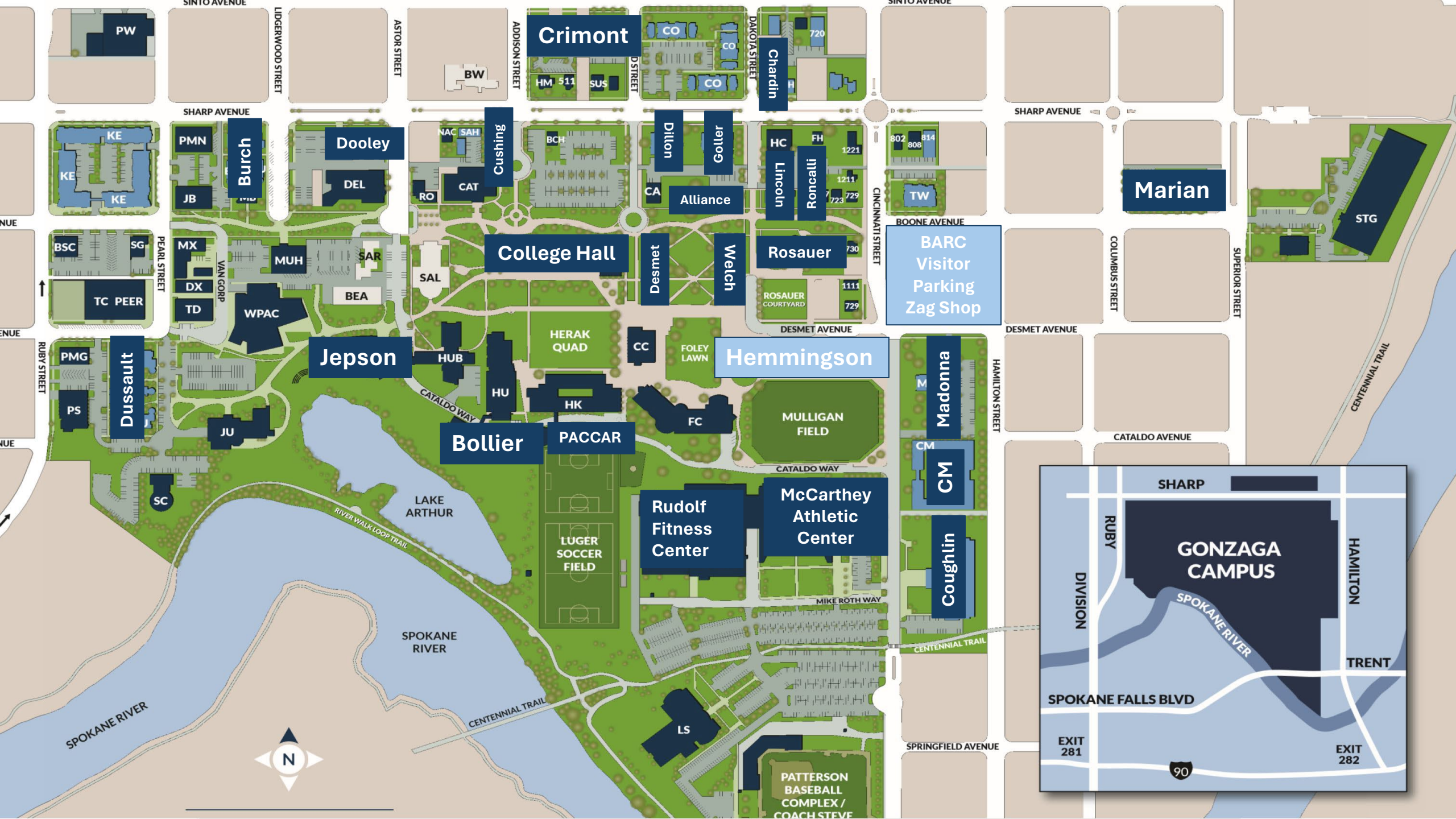

PLEASE BE AWARE

- Authorized Gonzaga staff will be in the buildings for necessary maintenance, repairs, cleaning, and safety patrols. Staff will be in identifiable GU uniforms (Or visible GU ID) and may be present throughout the day and night as necessary.
- Buildings with planned maintenance and repairs by 3rd party vendors will have posted signage on the main entrance(s) of the building.
- Third Party Vendors will enter the buildings for planned maintenance and repairs during regular business hours. Vendors will be in identifiable attire and will be in the building only during regular hours (8am-6pm, 7 days a week). *After hours work may occur in the case of emergencies.*
- Staff and vendors will be in any public spaces, and in identified work/construction areas throughout the buildings including lobbies, corridors, and open spaces.
- FOR YOUR SAFETY, doors should not be propped open while on campus.
- Always lock your rooms and maintain control to the key to your assigned room.
